## 1 Executive Summary

eBiz is a significant initiative sponsored by Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion (DIPP), Government of India that seeks to establish a **one stop shop portal for all the G2B services** offered across the entire business life-cycle. The essence of eBiz is the creation of a **business-friendly environment** through a **service-oriented approach** to the needs of investors, industries and businesses.

The project involves **Integration with the departments** that interface with the business community across the three levels viz., Central, State and Local body. The eBiz portal while allowing business entities to transact with the government departments over the Internet also serves as a delivery channel for the department to offer their services online in a secure and transparent manner.

A pilot for the proposed project is conceived covering 25 services (*Refer Appendix II*), which include 14 services at the Central Government level and 11 services in each of the four states viz., Andhra Pradesh, Haryana, Maharashtra, and Uttar Pradesh.

The conceptualization of the eBiz pilot project involves “As-Is” and “eBiz enabled” process mapping for the identified list of 25 services and assessment of Functional requirements using which, an RFP for the pilot project will be floated by DIPP. Going forward, the scope of eBiz shall be extended to include all the G2B services across state and central government departments.

This document covers the “As-Is” process maps for the following services offered by the **Commissionerate of Industries, Andhra Pradesh for the Small Scale Industry** (hereafter referred as SSI).

1. **Provisional Registration of SSI unit under the Industries (Development and Regulation) Act, 1951**
2. **Permanent Registration of SSI unit under the Industries Development and Regulation Act, 1951**

## 2 Introduction

The Commissionerate of Industries (hereafter referred as department) is responsible for the administration of the provisions of the Industries (Development & Regulations) Act 1951, in the state of Andhra Pradesh. The main function of the department is to regulate and promote the industrial development in the state.

The department is headed by Commissioner of Industries. The Commissioner of Industries is supported by Additional Directors and the Additional Secretaries. The Additional Secretary, SSI, supervises the work of the general managers working at the district level offices, known as District Industries Centers (DIC), in the state. There are 23 DIC in the state. The DIC functions as primary source of interaction between the different industries and the department.

The department offers the following services to the different industries:

The department co-ordinates with various industry related government departments, corporations and industrial associations in organizing state, national and international business conferences / seminars / work shops / exhibitions / investment promotion campaigns etc. for transfer of technology and for promotion of large investments in the state.

An industrial undertaking, in which the investment in fixed assets in plant and machinery whether held on ownership terms on lease or on hire purchase does not exceed Rs. 10 million, is defined as Small Scale Industry (SSI) under the provisions of the Industries (Development & Regulation) Act, 1951 (hereafter referred as Act).

This classification is not applicable for units which are owned, controlled or is a subsidiary of any other industrial undertaking. The registration of SSI units is not mandatory under the provisions of the Act and is voluntary. However this registration enables the SSI to obtain certain privileges from other agencies.

### 3 Description of the Service

#### Provisional Registration of Small Scale Industry Unit

The SSI provisional registration certificate enables the business entity to obtain certain privileges during pre operative period such as

1. Term loans and working capital from financial institutions/banks under priority sector lending.
2. Facilities for accommodation, land, other approvals etc.
3. Various necessary clearances from regulatory bodies

The provisional registration certificate is issued for a maximum period of five years from its date of issue. The certificate is valid till the date of commencement of production or for a period of five years from the date of issue, whichever is earlier.

Depending upon the type of the classification of the SSI as per the provisions of the Pollution Control Board, the provisional registration of the SSI presently is provided through two channels. A synopsis of each of these two channels for registration is provided below:

- Online registration on <http://www.aponline.gov.in>: All those small scale industrial units which do not fall under the highly polluting categories as given by the Pollution Control Board can obtain the provisional registration certificate from the web site <http://www.aponline.gov.in> .
- District Industries Center: The units which are classified as highly polluting by the Pollution Control Board can obtain their provisional registration certificate of SSI by applying for it at the concerned District Industries Center.

### 4 Description of the As-Is Process

#### 4.1 Provisional Registration of less polluting SSI unit

The facility for online provisional SSI registration is applicable for SSI units, which are outside the classification of Pollution Control Board as highly polluting industries. List of the industries, which are excluded from the online provisional SSI registration facility, is given in *Annexure I*. Such SSI units are required to apply for the registration at the concerned District Industries Center (DIC).

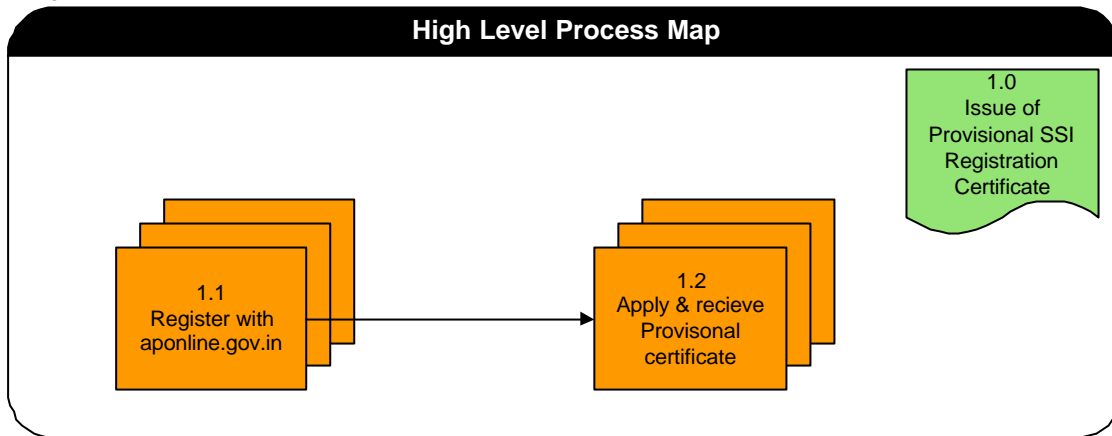
The online registration process for the SSI provisional registration involves the following activities:

- Process 1.1: Register with [aponline.gov.in](http://www.aponline.gov.in) (required only in case of users not registered with the website)
- Process 1.2: Apply and receive SSI provisional registration certificate\_online

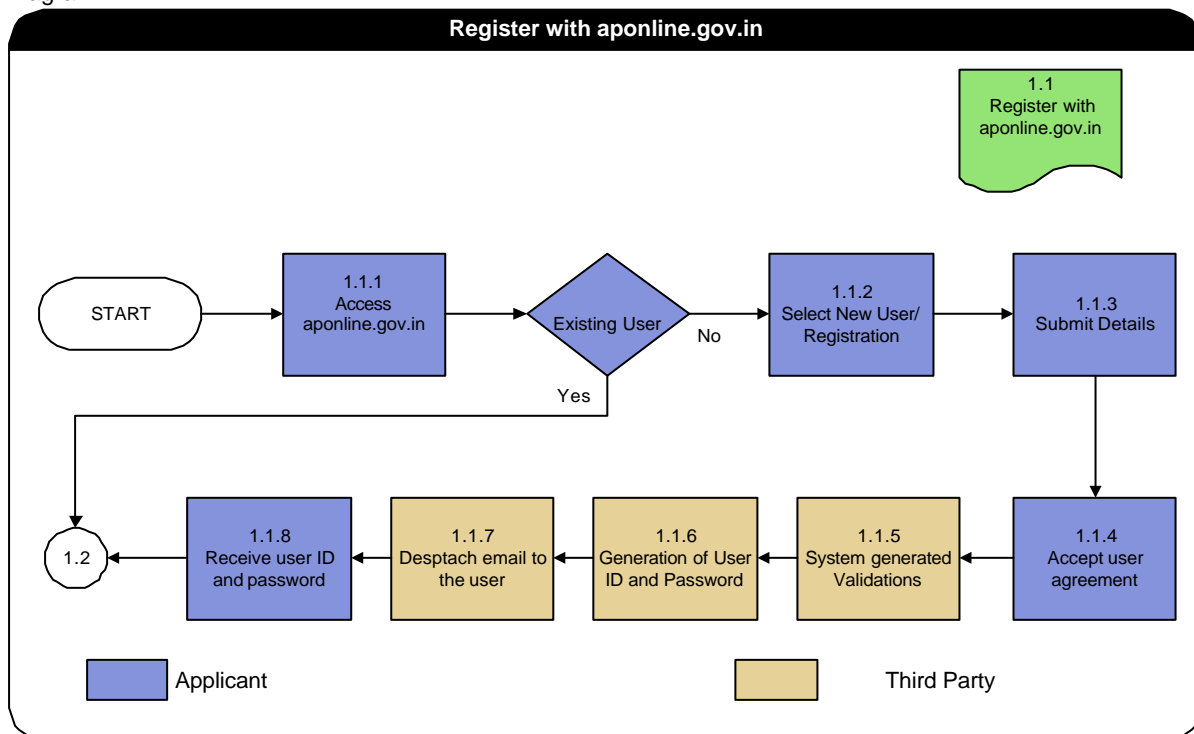

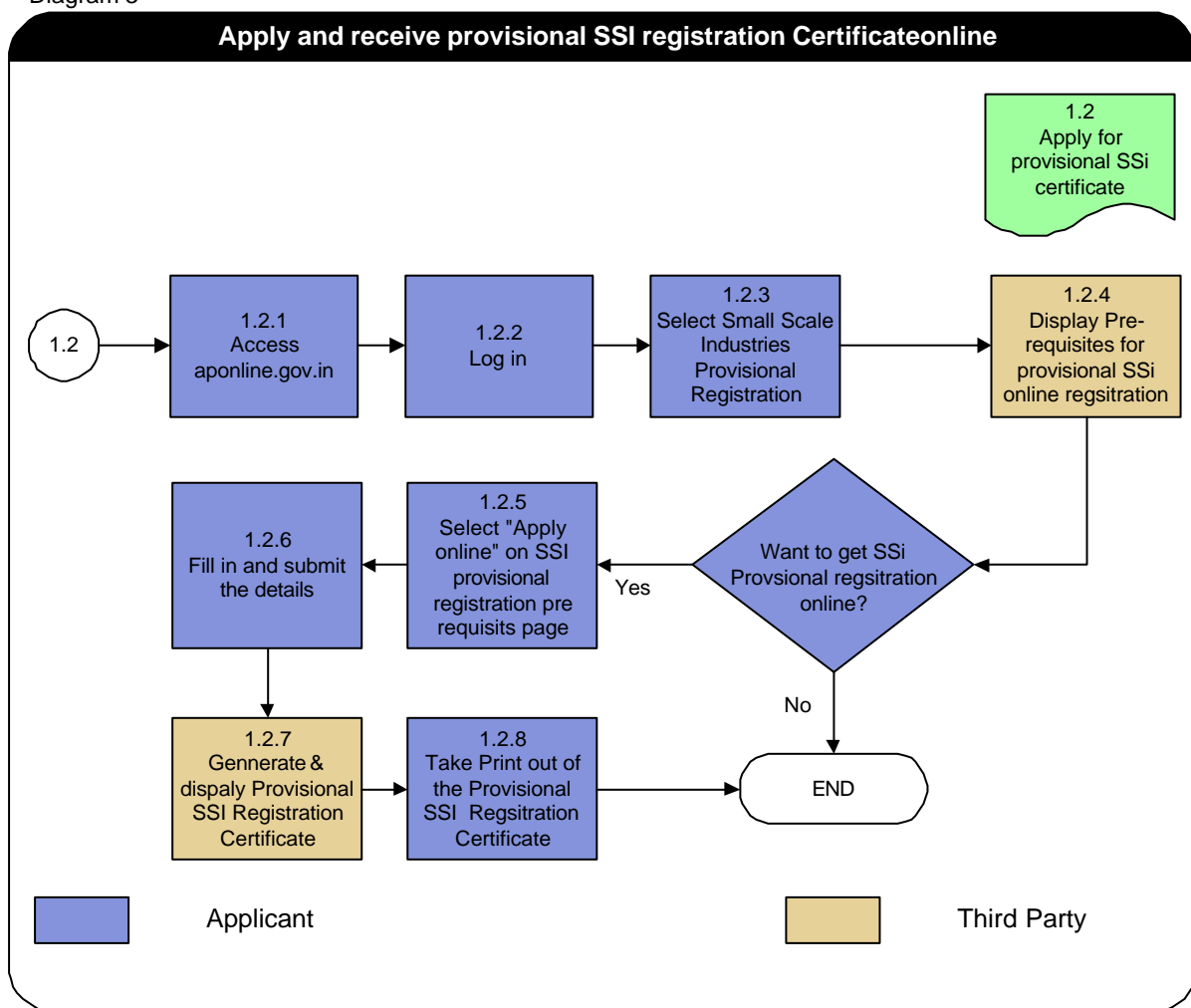
The service of online registration for the provisional SSI certificate for the approved categories is available to the users of <http://www.aponline.gov.in> only. The applicant must first register with the website for same. The registration on the website is a simple online process.

The applicant has to access the registration link on the website, complete the registration form and accept the user agreement. Once all the required details are entered and user agreement is accepted, the system processes the registration request. At this time the system also performs the inbuilt checks in order to ensure for the validation of the data entered. Thereafter a user id is allotted to the applicant for accessing the services available on <http://www.aponline.gov.in>. At the same time a system generated mail is also sent to the applicant confirming his registration with [aponline.gov.in](http://www.aponline.gov.in). This process does not involve any submission of documents or payment of fees.

### Process 1.2: Apply and receive SSI Provisional Registration Certificate online

The following process map (diagram 3) details the steps for obtaining the provisional SSI registration certificate online.

The user of the <http://www.aponline.gov.in> logs on to the website and selects to use the registration service for the provisional registration for SSI units. As soon as he clicks on the link, the system displays the following prerequisites for applying for the registration.

1. Data should be entered in all fields of the form which are marked with asterisk (\*).
2. Guidelines given on the form for filling
3. Provisional registration for SSI cannot be done for a line of manufacture which falls under restricted product categories. It cannot also be issued if the location of the SSI violates the guidelines for locations provided by the Commissionerate of Industries, Government of Andhra Pradesh.

The user can select to continue, if his industry does not fall in the red category as defined by PCB. In case he does not want to proceed further, the process gets terminated. On selecting “Apply Online” the system generates an online application form for provisional registration of SSI. The following table lists out the information to be submitted for online application form of provisional registration of SSI.

\* This part of the form deals with declaration for the category of unit for the proposed SSI setup. It lists out those categories of unit which cannot be set up online. The list of these items is reproduced in *Annexure 1*.

Once the user submits the completed application form, system performs some automatic validations on the data entered. The validation performed by the system is not for the accuracy of data but it only checks whether some input has been given in the form. After the validation, the system generates the online provisional SSI registration certificate. The online certificate displays the following:

Note: This certificate is not applicable for following industries:

1. Categorized as 'Red' by the AP Pollution Control Board
2. Manufacturing items in the prohibited category
3. Located in prohibited areas
4. Having investment of more than 1.00 crore (Rupees one crore only) on Plant & Machinery.

The user may take the printout of this certificate. In this entire process, the user is not required to submit any attachments or documents. This process of obtaining provisional SSI registration certificate does not require any payment of fees.

Note: The website <http://www.aponline.gov.in> is not maintained by the Commissionerate of Industries. The data collected by the website is sent to the DIC on a periodic basis.

#### **4.2 Provisional Registration of highly polluting SSI unit**

The process for manual registration applicable to the category of SSI units, declared by Pollution Control Board as highly polluting, begins by giving an application in the concerned DIC and ends with the issue of Registration certificate

##### **Process 2.1: Issue of Provisional SSI Registration Certificate at DIC**

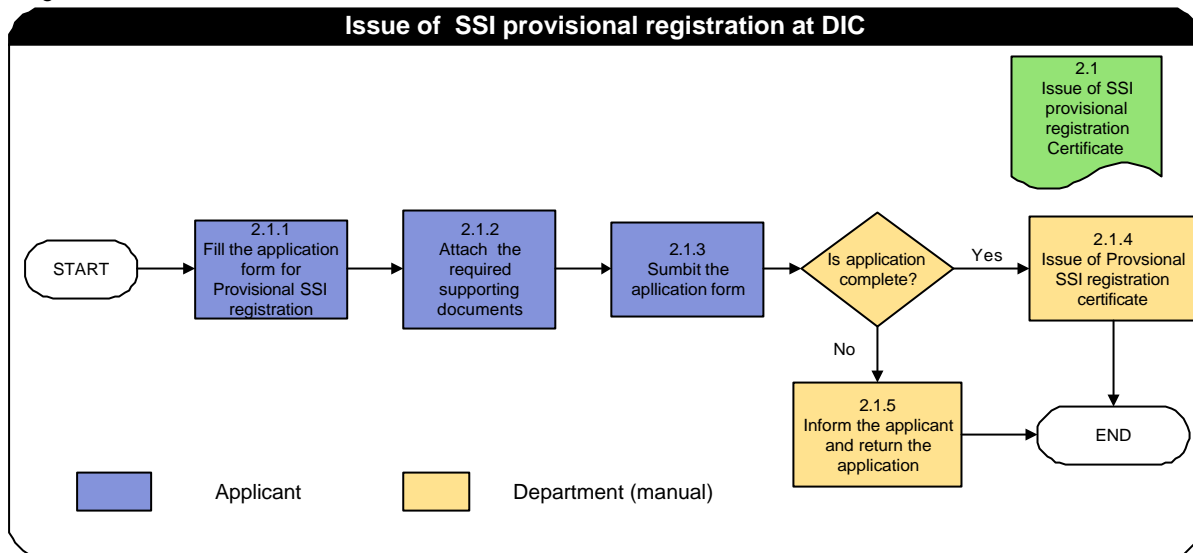
The procedure involved in obtaining the SSI provisional registration involves the following activities.

1. Apply for the provisional Registration at DIC
2. Submit the required documents.
3. Issue of provisional SSI registration certificate

The following process map (diagram 4) explains the procedure for obtaining provisional registration certificate through manual route.

The applicant approaches the concerned DIC with the completed application form and attaches the required supporting documents. In case of partnership firms and companies, the supporting documents required are as under:

- Partnership Firm : Copy of the Partnership Deed
- Company : Copy of Memorandum of Association

Apart from this all the units seeking registration through DIC have to submit the Consent for Establishment issued by the Pollution Control Board. If the application is complete and the supporting documents are attached with the application, the provisional registration certificate is issued to the applicant across the table. There is no requirement for payment of fess for obtaining the provisional registration.

If the application is incomplete, the applicant is informed of the same and is asked to resubmit the application. The application is not kept pending in the DIC.

## 5 Description of the Service

### Permanent Registration of Small Scale Industry Unit

The registration of the SSI with the Department of Industries is voluntary as per the provisions of the Act. However permanent registration enables the unit to get the following incentives/ concessions:

- Income-Tax exemption and Sales Tax exemption as per State Govt. Policy
- Price and purchase preference for goods produced
- Availability of raw material depending on existing policy

A small scale undertaking can apply for the permanent registration certificate after the date of commencement of production.

The service for the permanent registration of SSI is offered through a single delivery channel at the respective District Industries Center (DIC). The applicant must apply for the permanent registration certificate in the application form and submit it along with the required documents. The permanent registration certificate of SSI is issued by the General Manager, District Industries Center based upon the recommendation of the Industry Promotion Officer at the DIC

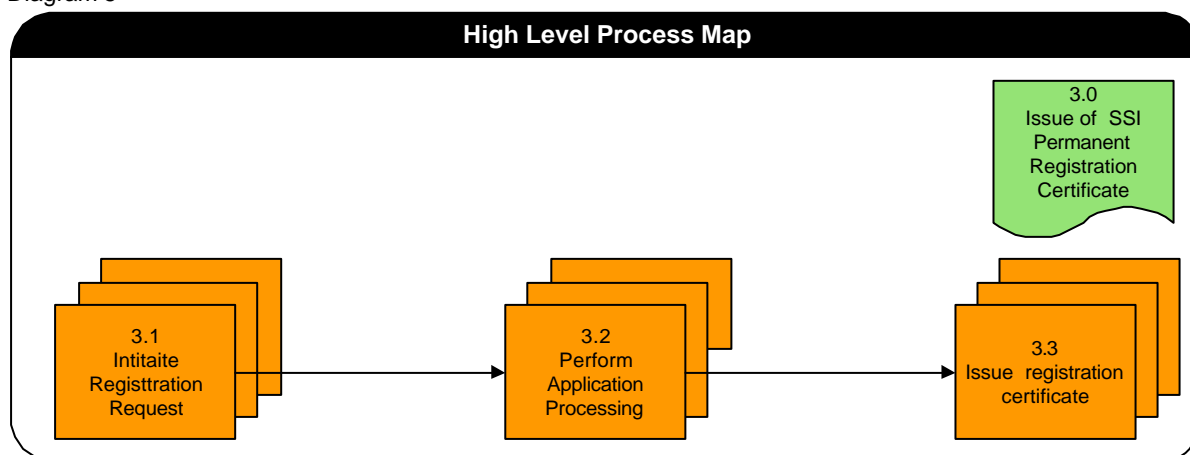
## 6 Description of the As-Is Process

The registration of the SSI units with the department of industries is a voluntary exercise. However, the permanent registration certificate is a prerequisite for certain other privileges. The procedure for obtaining the SSI permanent registration begins with the filling of application at the concerned DIC and ends with the issue of permanent registration certificate. The process involves the following activities:

- Process 3.1: Initiate Registration Request
- Process 3.2: Perform Application Processing
- Process 3.3: Issue of registration certificate

The following process map (diagram 5) gives a high level overview of the sub-processes involved in the issue of the registration certificate for permanent SSI registration. The detailed description of the activities involved in each of the sub-processes is given in the subsequent sections.

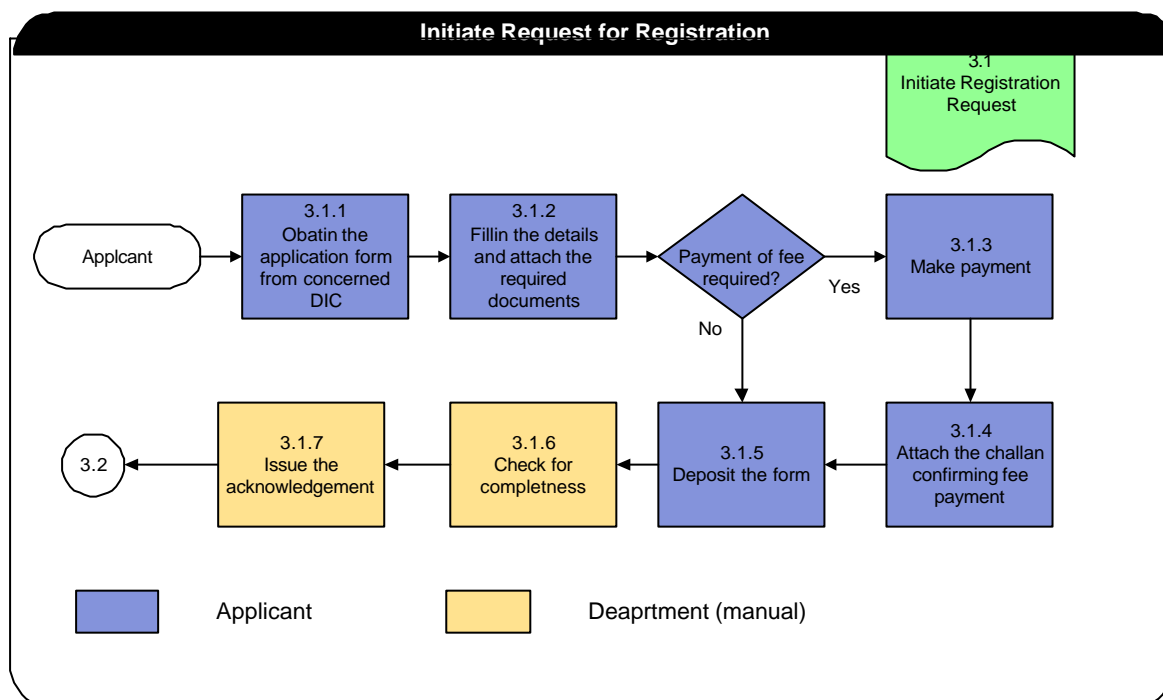

### Process 3.1: Initiate Registration Request

The application for the permanent registration has to be submitted at the concerned DIC. The following process map (diagram 6) details the steps required for applying at the DIC for permanent registration.

The applicant approaches the concerned DIC office and collects the application form for the permanent registration. He fills in all the required information and attaches the various documents as a proof of the correctness of the information submitted. The application (in duplicate) must be accompanied with the following supporting documents required for permanent registration of SSI unit.

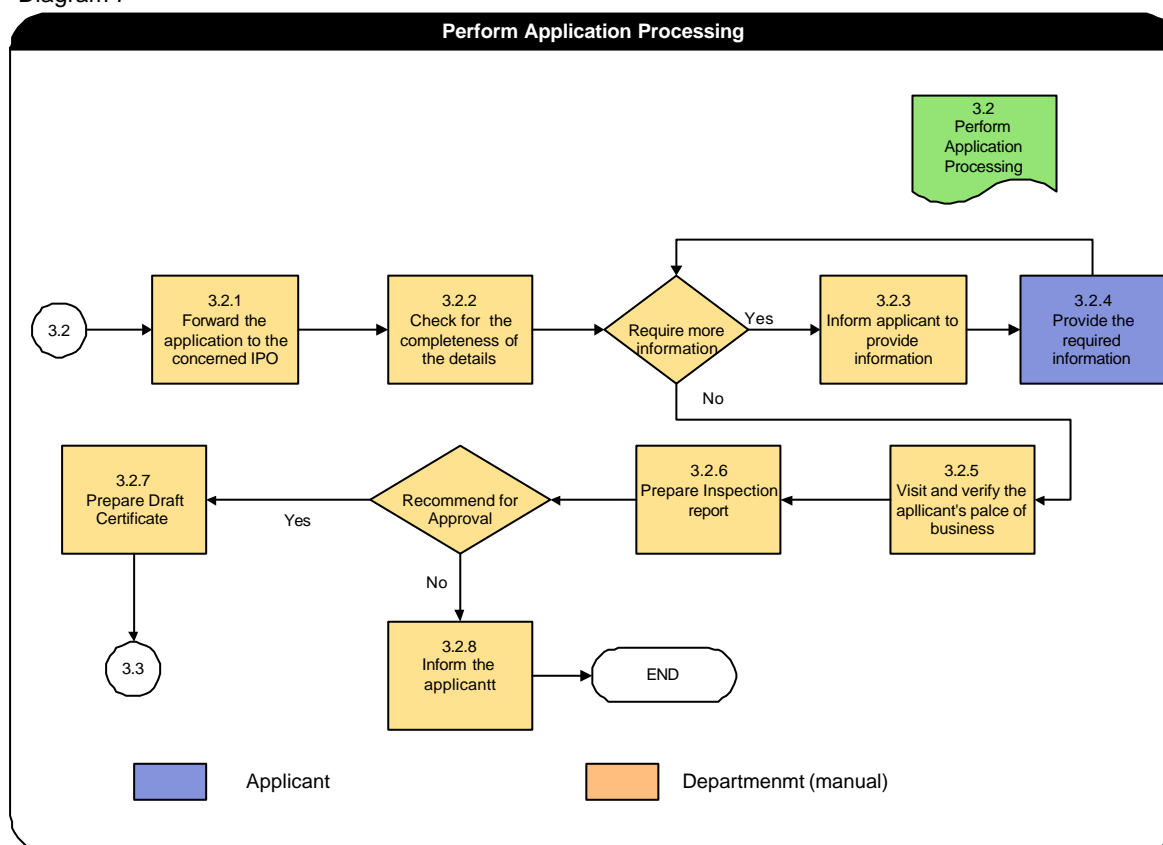
If the investment in plant and machinery exceeds rupees one hundred thousand, the applicant must submit a fees of Rs One hundred (Rs. 100). The fee has to be paid in the branch of State Bank of Hyderabad, in the account of General Manager, District Industries Center, of the concerned District Industries Center.

The department clerk accepts the form, validates for the information submitted and proof of fee payment (if required) and issues an acknowledgement copy of the form to the applicant.

### Process 3.2: Perform Application Processing

On receipt of the application form the next step is application processing which involves the verification of the documents and site inspection. The following process map (diagram 7) displays the steps in the processing of the application.

The clerk receives the application and forwards it to the concerned Industrial Promotion Officer (IPO). The IPO undertakes the following activities

1. Verification of the documents and information in the form
2. Queries the missing information or the documents from the applicant
3. Conducts site inspection

During the site inspection, the IPO performs the following checks:

1. The unit has obtained all necessary clearances whether statutory or administrative. e.g. drug license under drug control order, CFE/CFO from Pollution Control Board (if required), etc.
2. Unit does not violate any location restrictions in force, at the time of evaluation.

3. Value of plant and machinery is within prescribed limits.
4. Unit is not owned, controlled or subsidiary of any other industrial undertaking as per notification

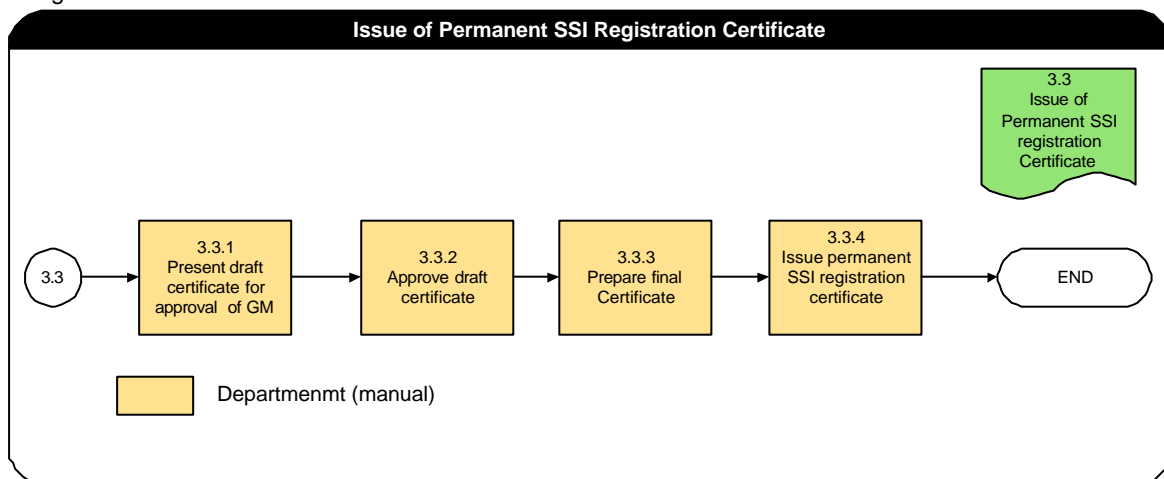
After the site verification, the IPO prepares the site visit report. Based on the site visit and document verification, the IPO may take either of the following decisions.

- Reject the application: In this case, the applicant is informed and the application processing is stopped.
- Recommend approval of the request: In this case, the IPO prepares the draft certificate and sends it along with the application file and site visit report to the General Manager for his approval.

### Process 3.3: Issue of Permanent SSI Registration Certificate

The following process map (diagram 8) explains the process of issue of the permanent registration certificate by the District Industries Center.

The General Manager of the concerned DIC reviews the inspection report of the Industry Promotion Officer and approves the draft certificate. While deciding about the grant of the permanent registration, he is required to make sure that it is not against the policies and guidelines issued by the department. Once the General Manager approves the draft certificate it is given back to the Industry Promotion Officer.

Thereafter the Industry Promotion Officer prepares the final certificate, which is then issued to the applicant.

## 7 Description of the IT Infrastructure

### 7.1 Software Application

The District Industries Centre is not using any application for delivering the services, described in this document, to the business entities. However, at the central office of the Commissionerate of Industries, an application is being used for the generation of pay slips of the employees working in the central office. This application has been designed and developed by National Informatics Centre

(NIC). This application is called as Employee Payroll System-NIC-APSU. This application works on MS Windows XP and it uses MS Access as its database.

The Department has delegated the facility of online provisional registration of SSI through website <http://aponline.gov.in>. This website is being maintained by Tata Consultancy Services. A report is sent to the department at the end of the month of the registrations done through the website.

## 7.2 Hardware and Networking Infrastructure

Each of the DIC has some computer systems which are on Local Area Network. The DICs are not connected by Wide Area Network but they have a facility to connect to Internet through dial-up connections.

The official web site of Commissionerate of Industries is <http://apind.gov.in>. This website is more informatory in nature. It list out the information of various issues concerning the department.
